Take turns reading the questions aloud from the question cards. Write your answers on your respective worksheets.

When you're done filling out all the answers, take some time to compare your responses to see where you overlap or differ.

Question 3:

Question 4:

Question 5:

Is anyone from either of our families planning to contribute financially to our wedding? If so, how much?

Question 6:

Question 7:

What are the things we like to do together? Do you enjoy going to concerts together or riding bikes in the park? Make a list of the things you enjoy doing as a couple.



Is there any location that has a special significance to you as a couple? (ie where you met, the location of your first date, etc)





Question 9:

What are your favorite memories together? Think about your favorite vacations or trips, special dates or anniversaries.

Question 10:

Is there a song or lyric that has special meaning to you? Is there a band that both of you share as a favorite?
